COURSE DESCRIPTION

The combination of fashion and Paris is alluring unlike any other city during fashion week. Shooting at fashion shows is an exclusive media privilege. However street fashion photography, captured by master photographers such as Bill Cunningham and made famous by bloggers such as the Sartorialist, is a completely different approach and at times more in demand with publications than the traditional runway shots.

Through a series of workshops during Haute Couture Paris Fashion week, you will be introduced to street style fashion photography whilst developing refined camera craft skills in lighting and composition. You will also produce a digital folio, within the breathtaking backdrop of Paris.

LEARNING OUTCOMES

Upon successful completion of the course, students should have the following skills and knowledge:

- Understand use of light (both natural and artificial lighting) within the context of street fashion/portraiture
- Composition
- Understand how to capture people in an environment where the subject matter is the people
- How to approach and direct real people in unfamiliar environments
- Quickly evaluate lighting and composition within an environment under various scenario
- Attain an overview of photographing street style fashion portraiture at Paris fashion week

ASSESSMENT

Students will be assessed on the following criteria:

- Class participation and preparation: 20%
- In-class assignments 30%
- Homework assignments: Fashion Week portfolio 50%

Composition lecture 1- exercise - review. Camera techniques: depth of field, wide angle vs tele lens, etc. Demo and in-class exercise. Preparing for shooting on location 1: how to approach (technically, aesthetically, post production and feed back review) – Exercise 1 on location

Wednesday, 06/19

Basic beauty retouching demonstrations and exercise. Composition lecture 2- exercise - review. Preparing for shooting on location 1: how to approach (technically, aesthetically, post production and feed back review) – Exercise location 1

Thursday, 06/20

Color theory: exercise color schemes.

Preparing for shooting on location 2: how to approach (technically, aesthetically, post production and feed back review) – Exercise 2 on location Palais Royal. Digital Lab session

Friday, 06/21

Review color scheme exercise.

Preparing for shooting on location 2: how to approach (technically, aesthetically, post production and feed back review) – Exercise 2 on location Marais. Post production & presentation of Week 1 Exercises DUE = 30% Review & preparation for Week 2 on site live fashion week. Digital Lab session.
